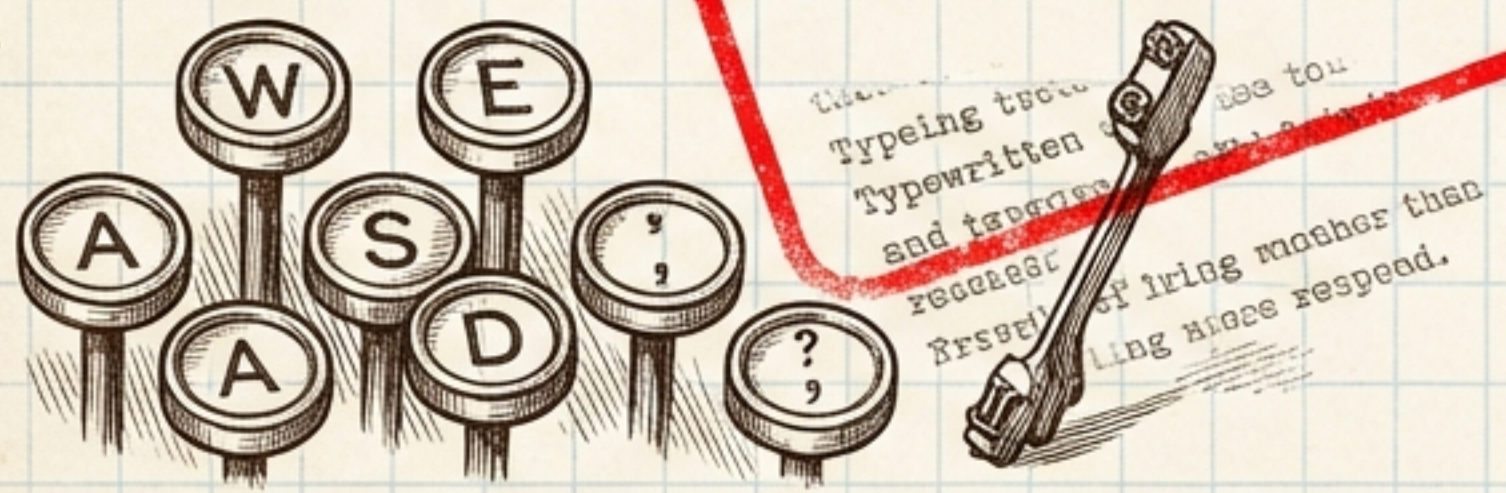

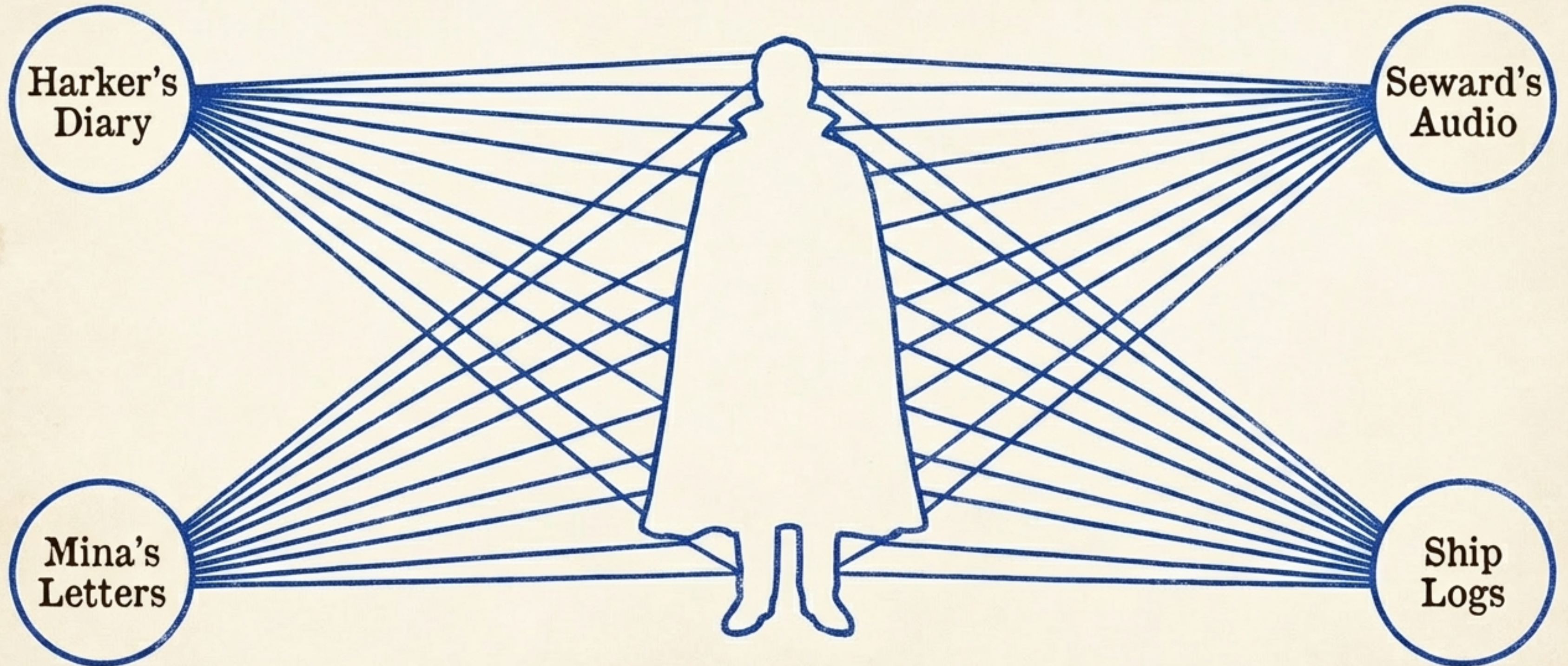

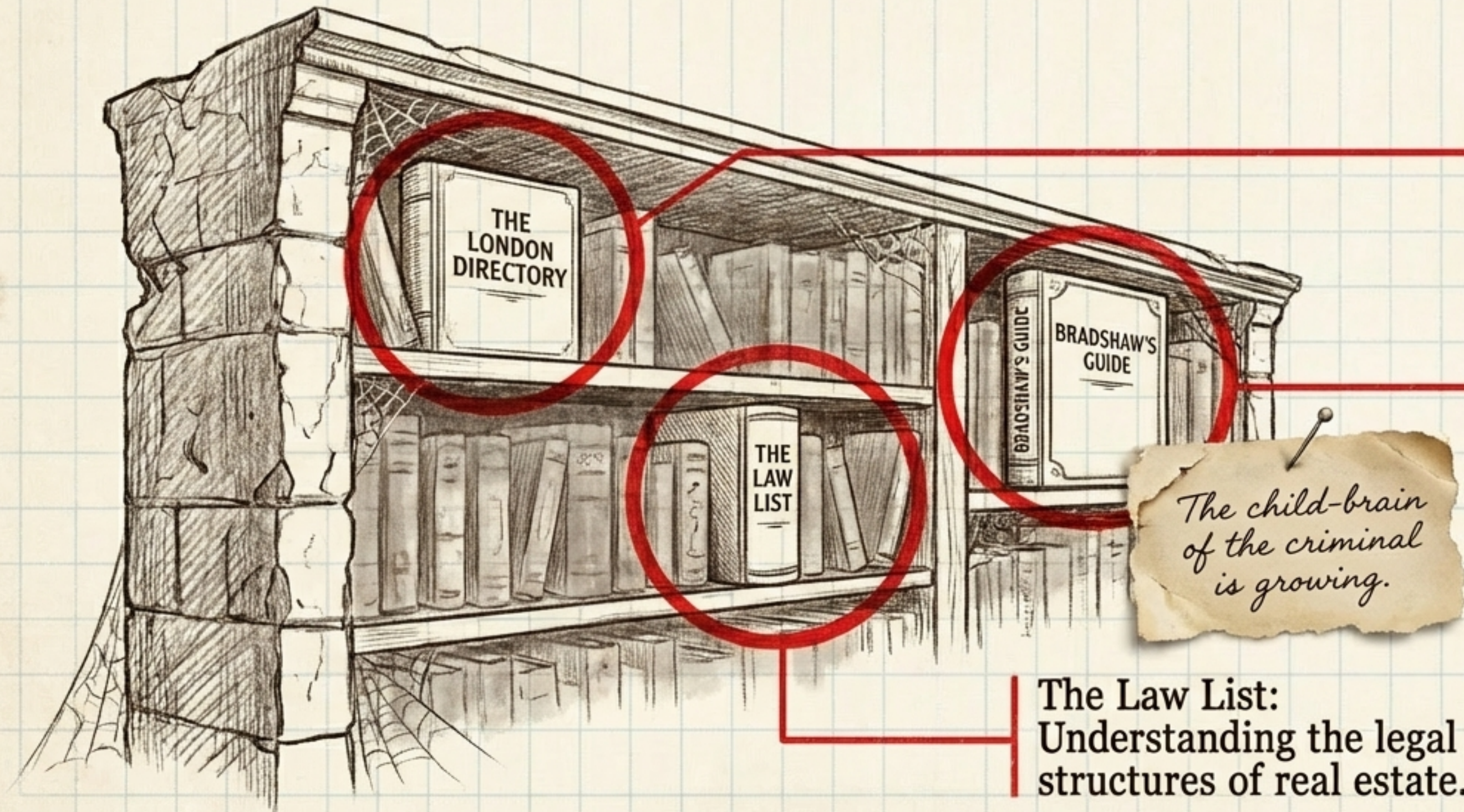
The Architecture of Fear

Arsenal	Limitations

Commands the rat, the owl, the bat, the wolf	Cannot enter a house unless first invited
Directs the elements (storm, fog, thunder)	Power ceases at sunrise
Shapeshifting (elemental dust, mist)	Cannot cross running water except at slack or flood tide

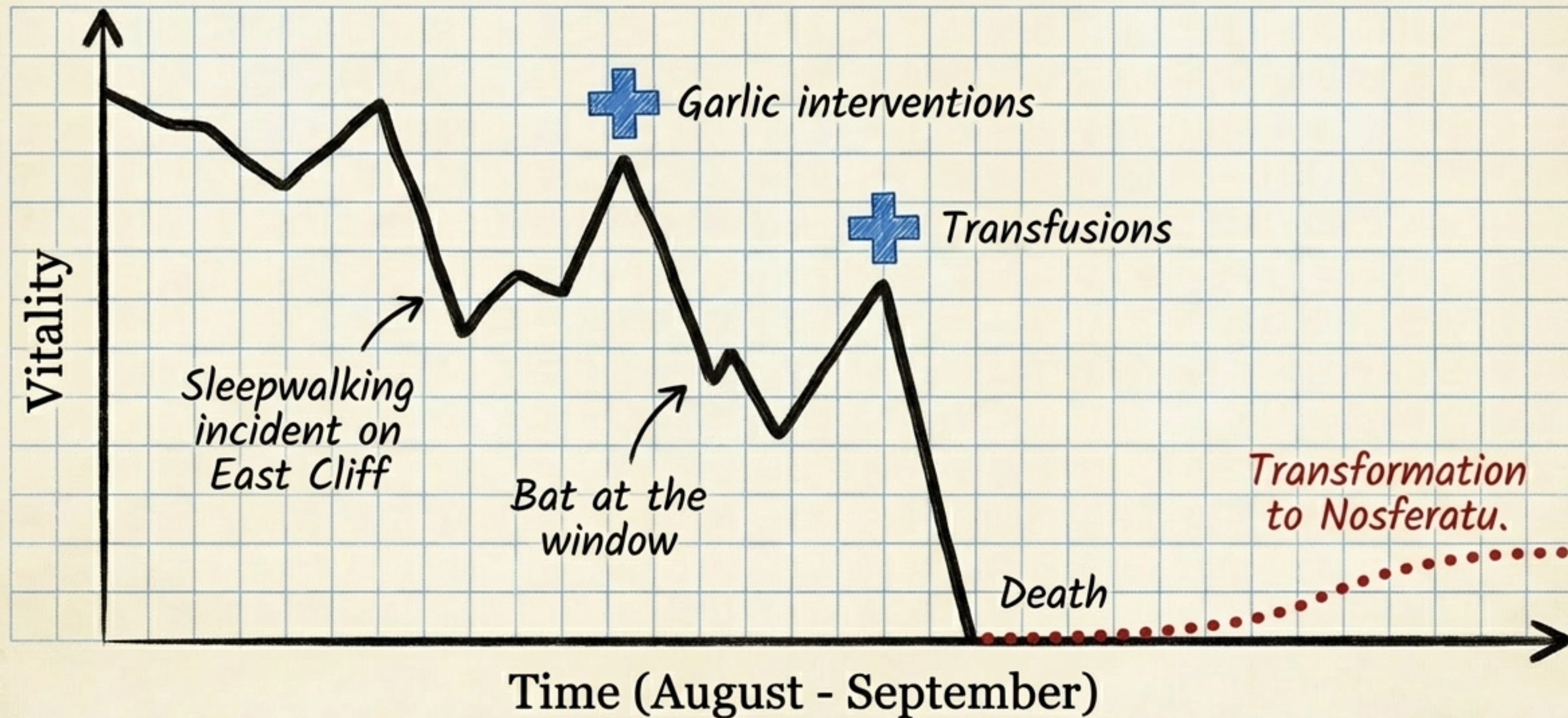
The Vampire's Logistics

The invasion of London was a massive cargo operation. Dracula required the covert transport of 50 wooden boxes of Transylvanian earth to survive.



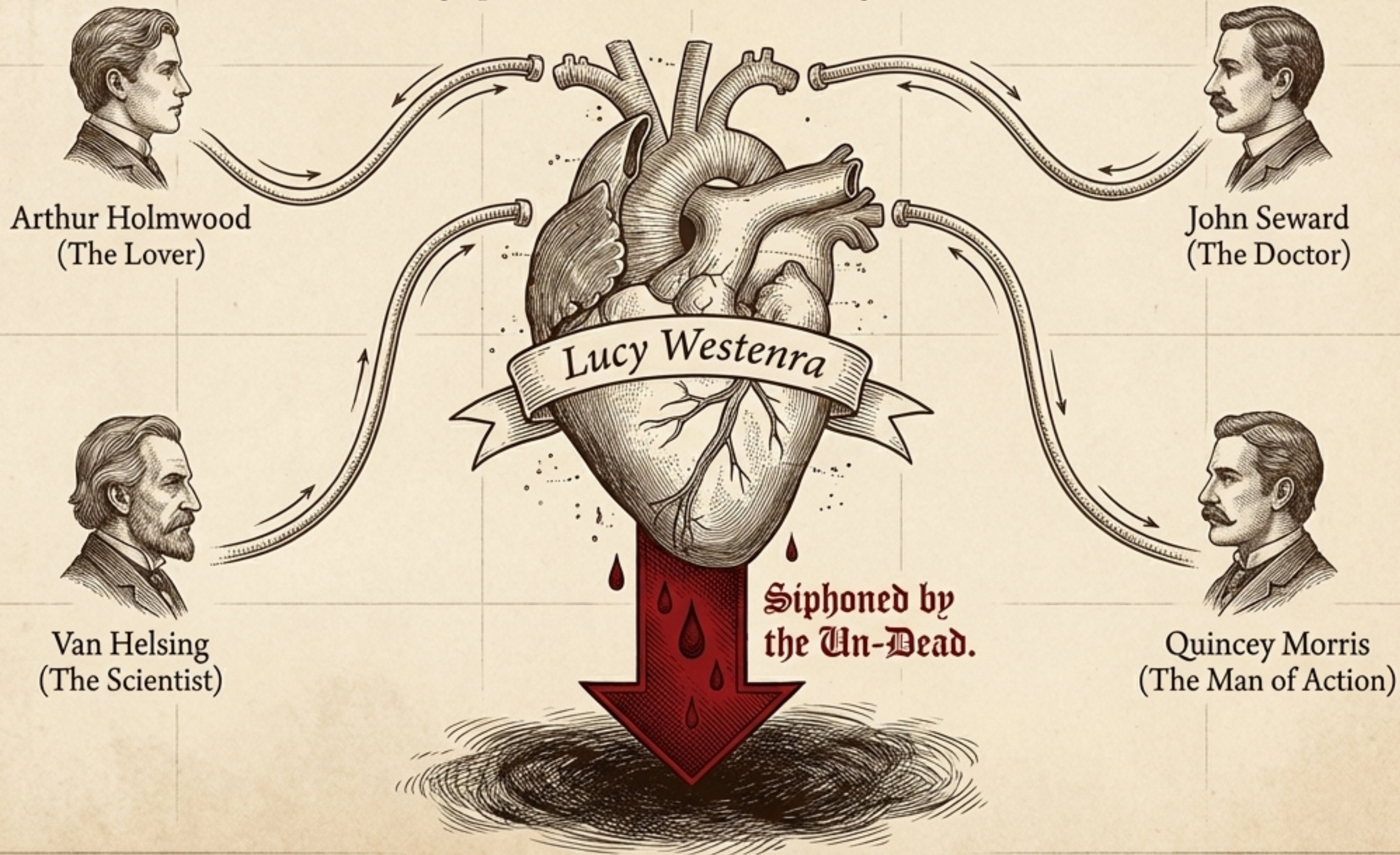
Anatomy of a Curse

Four men literally drain their own life force into Lucy to combat the disease, establishing a profound, collective blood-tie against the invader.



The Clash of Eras

At its core, the narrative is not simply good versus evil. It is a war between ancient Eastern superstition and cutting-edge 19th-century Western technology.

The Antiquity (Dracula)

⚙️ Winchester rifles, blood transfusions, steam launches.

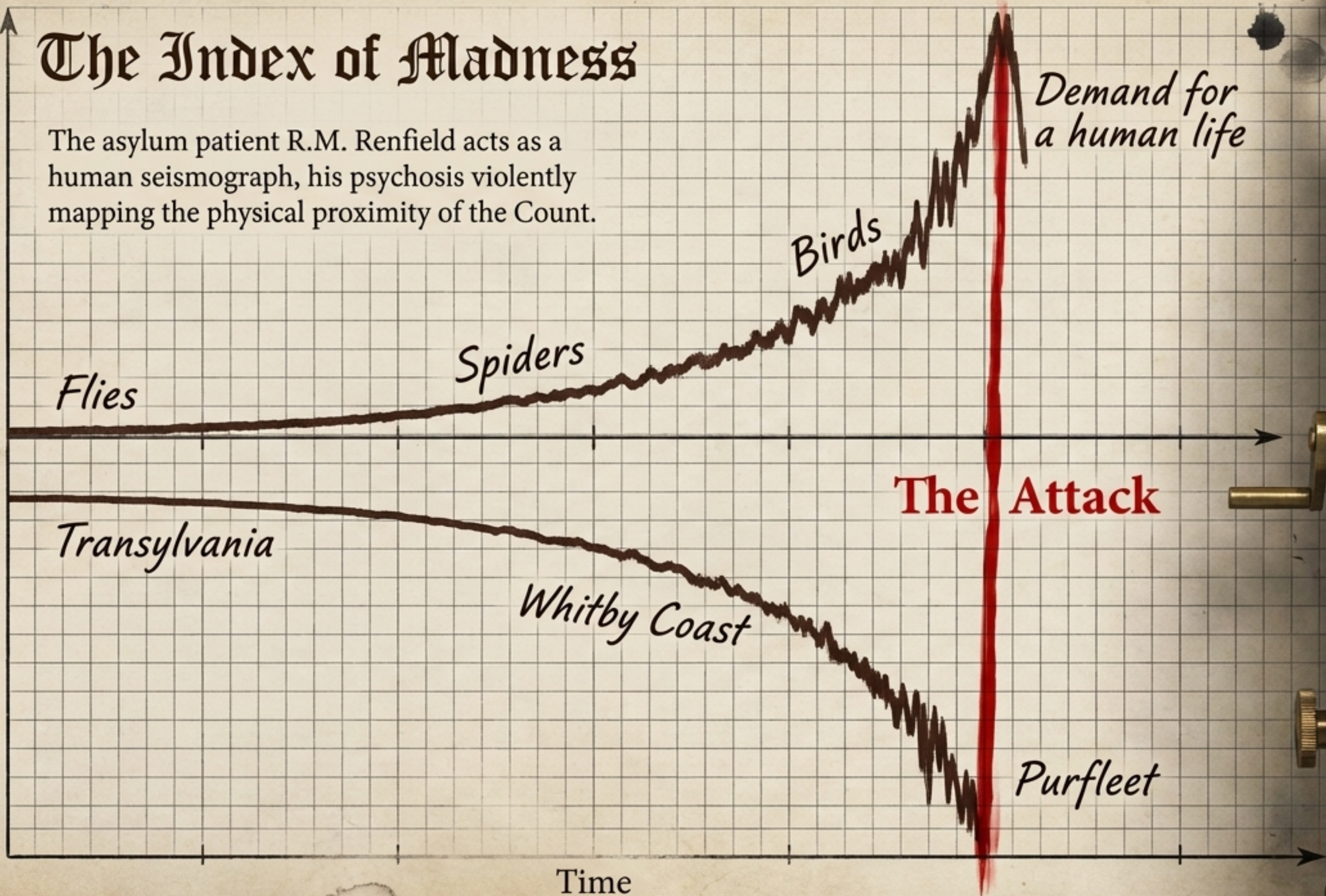
Communication:

The Tale of Two Women

Two women are targeted by the Count. Their differing fates are dictated by their relationship to the group and their command of information.



Lucy Westenra

- Isolated in Whitby
- Passive victim of sleepwalking
- Guarded by men who keep her in the dark

Succumbs and transforms.



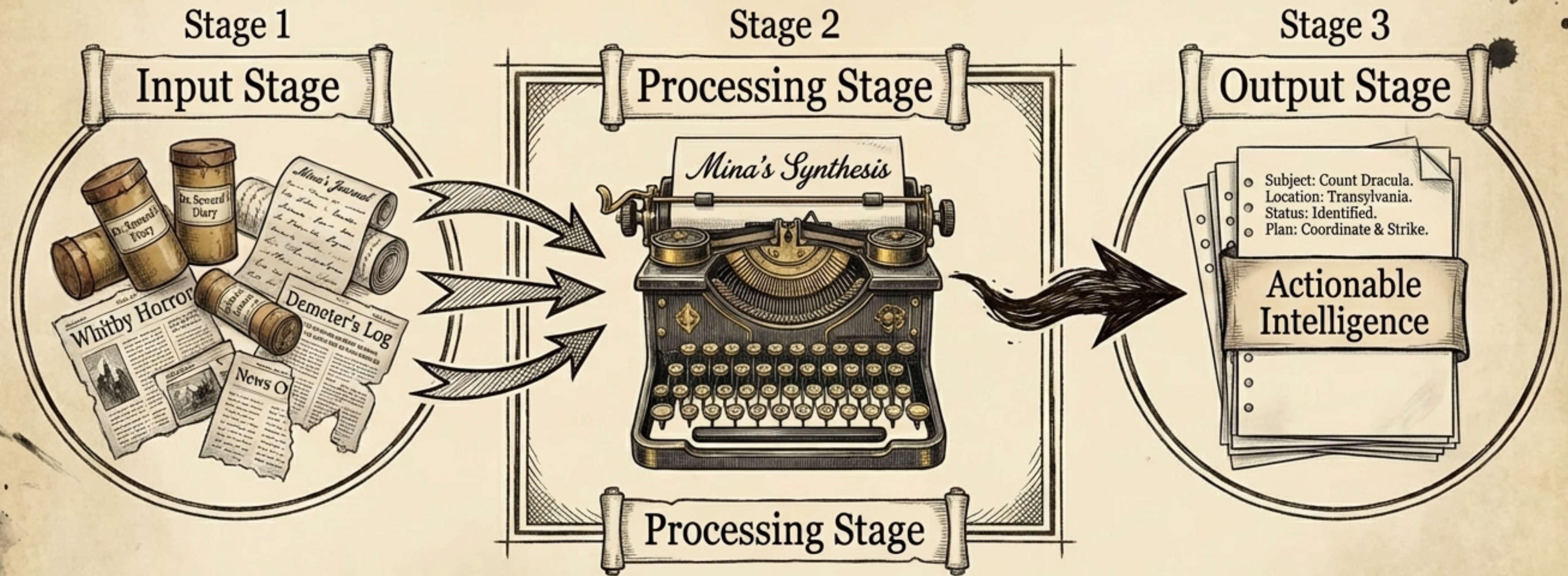
Mina Harker

- Integrated into the core team
- Active investigator using modern tools (typewriter, shorthand)
- Becomes the intellectual hub of the group

Survives and directs the counter-attack.

The Ultimate Weapon: Information Management

Isolated individuals are prey. A transparent, data-sharing collective is invincible.

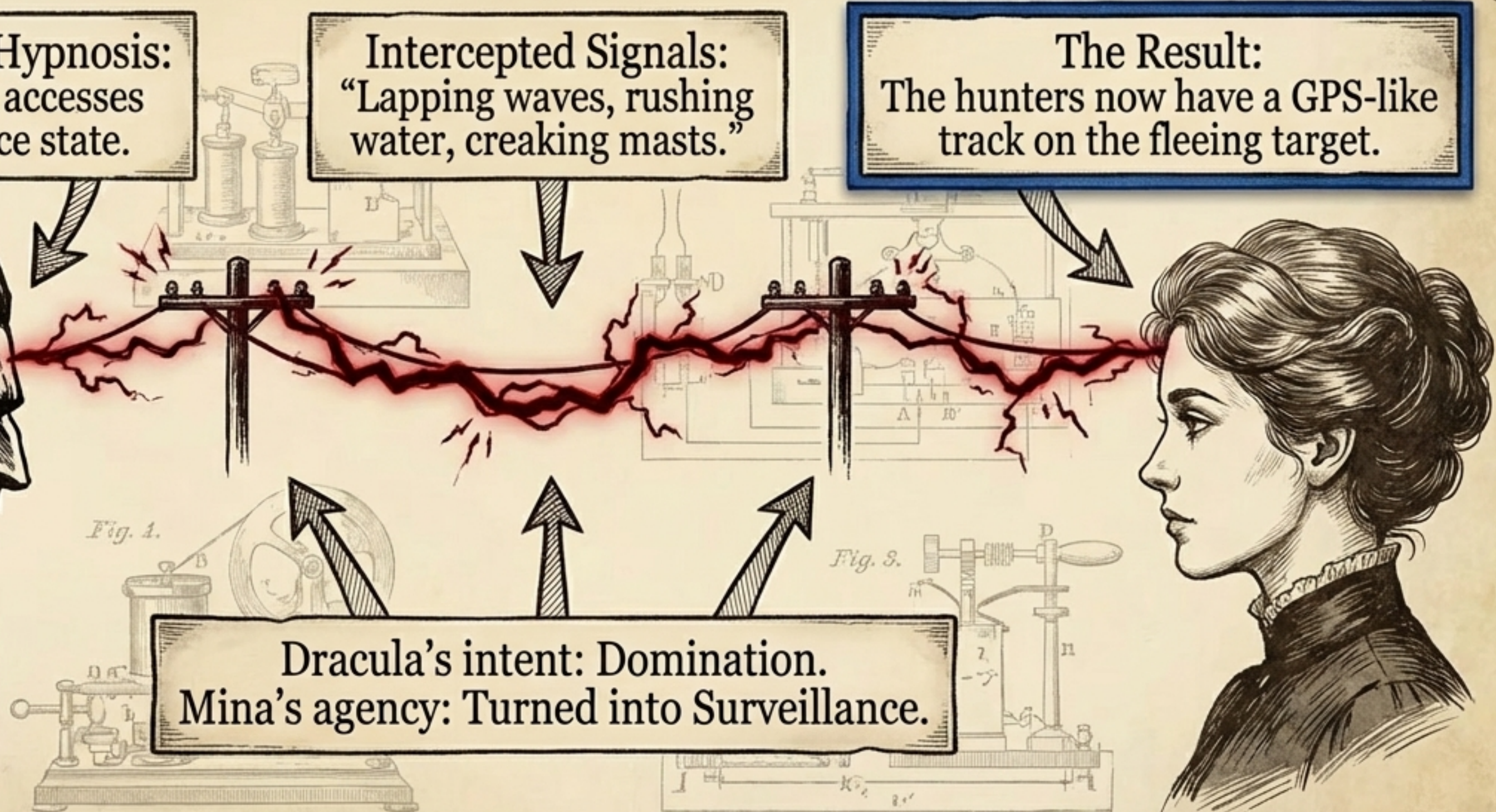
The Mental Tether

Dracula retaliates by attacking the Archive itself, infecting Mina. But this curse inadvertently creates a two-way surveillance network.

Dusk/Dawn Hypnosis:

Mina's agency: Turned into Surveillance.



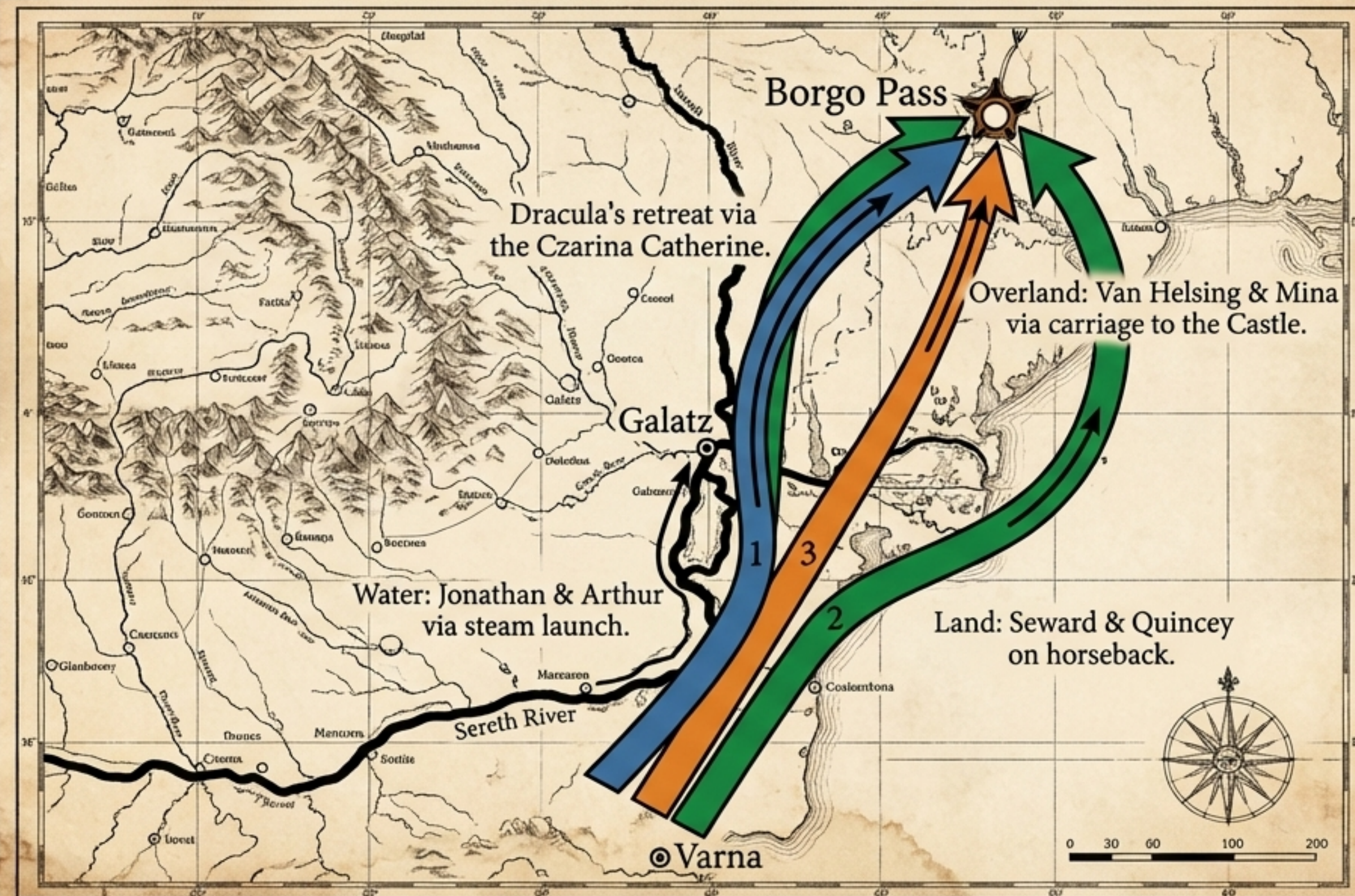
Sterilizing the Earth
